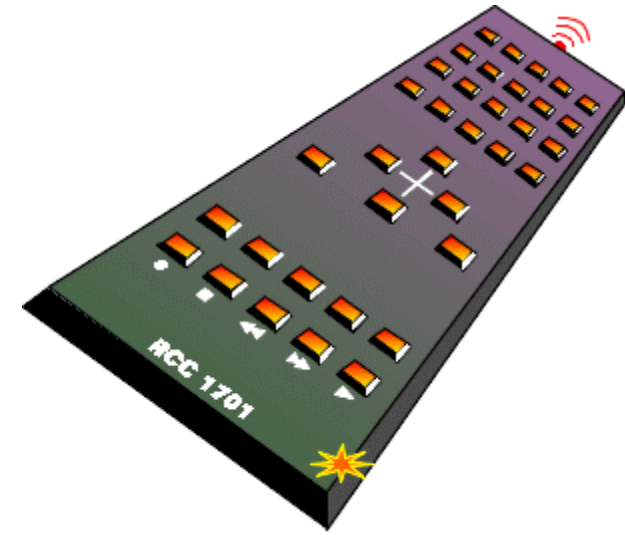

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Real Remote. The Real Remote is a complete package for controlling your Audio/MIDI programs. Batteries are not included.

Real Remote consists of a Remote Control, IR receiver and Controller Software. The Real Remote controller software use Macros consisting of mouse moves/clicks and key strokes in order to control your program.

Since Real Remote rely on the functionality of your MIDI/Audio program some of the functions indicated on the remote control may not apply to you.

The IR receiver is powered directly from the serial port. The current consumption is equal to a standard serial port mouse.

The system requirements is 486/33 MHz and Windows'9x or WindowsNT.

Installation

Make sure the computer is switched off and plug the IR receiver into an available serial port, normally on the back panel marked with "COM1", "COM2", "PORT A", "PORT B" or "COMM". If your computer do not have a 9pole D-sub socket, a 9-25 pin adaptor should be used.

When IR receiver is connected firmly to your computer, you should attach the IR receiver at a place where it can pick up the IR signals.

Run the **Setup.exe** file on the Real Remote disk.

To get started:

- Choose a template file.
- To run a macro: press a key on the remote control or double-click on a key in the Real Remote window.
- To run inverse function: press 'SHIFT' before the function key.
- To select a macro single-click on a key in the Real Remote window. The cursor show you which macro is selected.
- To record a macro: select a macro, press 'REC' + 'REC' buttons and stop the recording with the 'F2' key on your computer keyboard.
